HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE STATE OF HAWAII'S BOARD OF EDUCATION TO CHANGE THE SCHOOL NAME OF NOELANI ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO PRESIDENT BARACK HUSSEIN OBAMA II ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND/OR TO CHANGE THE SCHOOL NAME OF PRESIDENT WILLIAM MCKINLEY HIGH SCHOOL TO PRESIDENT BARACK HUSSEIN OBAMA II HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, it is of great significance that a kama'āina son of Hawai'i, born and raised in the Hawaiian Islands be elected as the $44^{\rm th}$ president of the United States of America; and
