
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO RECONSIDER ITS LEASE
PRICES WITH RENTAL CAR AGENCIES AT MOLOKAI AIRPORT.

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has statutory
2 authority to enter into leases with any person to confer the
3 privilege of supplying services at airports owned or controlled
4 by the Department, including Molokai Airport; and
5

6 WHEREAS, the Department is authorized to fix charges,
7 rentals, and fees for the privileges or services granted,
8 provided that the charges are reasonable and uniform for the
9 same class of privilege or service; and
10

11 WHEREAS, two major rental car agencies that have been
12 operating at Molokai Airport intend to cease operations this
13 year because the Department plans to raise their leases to
14 \$50,000 for five years, and a third major rental car agency is
15 exploring the possibility of entering into a lease at the
16 airport; and

18 WHEREAS, the lease increase will cause instability in an
19 already unstable and floundering tourism market; and
20

21 WHEREAS, the impending closure of the two major rental car
22 agencies will create an immediate loss of infrastructure for
23 Molokai's tourism industry, since car rentals are the only means
24 of transportation for tourists on the island; and
25

26 WHEREAS, the possible entry of a third major car rental
27 agency in the wake of the departure of the other two agencies
28 will transform the market for car rental services at the airport
29 into a monopoly, allowing the third agency to charge accordingly
30 for its services; now, therefore,
