HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT THE OAHU METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION AND THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND PERMITTING DEVELOP A PLANNING TEMPLATE FOR ENSURING SUFFICIENT REGIONAL HIGHWAY AND ROADWAY DEVELOPMENT TO MEET THE NEEDS OF EMERGING RESIDENTIAL COMMUNITIES IN THE EWA DEVELOPMENT PLAN AND THE WAIANAE SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES PLAN.

1 WHEREAS, there has been more than sufficient publicity describing the morass of traffic congestion in leeward Oahu and 2 the daily plight of leeward Oahu commuters; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the unchallenged cause of much of this congestion 5 6 is the unbridled growth in the Ewa Beach and Kapolei areas, despite the City and County of Honolulu's Ewa Development Plan, 7 8 as amended; and 9 10 WHEREAS, this growth in Ewa Beach and Kapolei has a direct impact upon the residents of the Waianae coast, from Nanakuli to 11 Makaha, who have to commute through these areas to get to 12 13 schools and jobs in Honolulu; and 14 WHEREAS, there have been many calls for regional highway 15 16 improvements intended to serve new residential developments to have been completed prior to, or concurrent with, the completion 17 of the new residential development; and 18 19 WHEREAS, many private developers decry what they refer to 20 as the "fallacy" of concurrency legislation, pointing to what 21 the private developers claim is a failure of the State and the 22 counties in not fulfilling their responsibilities to plan and 23 provide funding for necessary capital infrastructure 24 improvements in a timely manner; and 25 26
