HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO ENCOURAGE THE PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS TO ESTABLISH RESOURCE CENTERS ON THEIR CAMPUSES IN ORDER TO COMBAT HOMELESSNESS.

1 WHEREAS, thousands of Hawaii residents are homeless or at 2 risk of becoming homeless; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the slowing economy in Hawaii will subject 5 increasing numbers of people to financial stress and potential 6 homelessness; and 7 8 WHEREAS, a key element of the struggle against homelessness 9 is to ensure that families receive adequate, centralized information and referral with regard to existing health, human 10 11 service, educational, and legal resources that can help them to avoid homelessness, to cope with homelessness when it occurs, 12 and to take steps out of homelessness; and 13 14 WHEREAS, families that are homeless or at risk of becoming 15 homeless often lack ready and early access to adequate, 16 centralized information and referral; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, the public elementary schools are among the most recognizable, accessible, non-threatening, and widely used 20 resources in the community, and the administrators and teachers 21 22 in those schools have constant contact with and extensive 23 knowledge of the circumstances of families in their community; 24 and 25 WHEREAS, the Kamaile Elementary School, the Blanche Pope 26 Elementary School, and the Makaha Elementary School have 27 established resource centers that provide information and 28 29 referral; and 30

WHEREAS, existing data sets on homelessness are inadequate 1 2 to provide a complete, in-depth picture of the extent, nature, patterns, and circumstances of homelessness in communities 3 4 throughout the islands; and 5 WHEREAS, elementary school administrators, teachers, and 6 7 resource and referral centers often have the information 8 necessary to provide a more complete picture of homelessness; 9 now, therefore, 10 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 11 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 12 13 of 2009, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Education is urged to encourage the public elementary schools to establish 14 on-campus resource centers that provide information on, and 15 referral to, existing resources that can combat homelessness; 16 17 and 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education is 19 20 urged to foster the development of these resource centers as 21 sources of information on the extent, nature, patterns, and circumstances of homelessness in their communities; and 22 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the 25 26 Chairperson of the Board of Education, the Superintendent of Education, and the Chairperson of the Board of Trustees of the 27 Office of Hawaiian Affairs. 28 29 30 OFFERED BY: Coluin of So 31
