REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO ANALYZE A MEASURE TO REGULATE RESPIRATORY CARE PRACTITIONERS.

19 20 21 22 23	WHEREAS, referral shall be by concurrent resolution that identifies a specific legislative bill to be analyzed; and WHEREAS, House Bill No. 2009 proposing licensure of

27 28 29 30 31	BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2009, the Senate concurring, that the Auditor, pursuant to section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is requested to perform an analysis of the proposed regulation of respiratory care
