HOUSE RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING AND CONGRATULATING PAPAKOLEA HAWAIIAN HOMESTEAD UPON ITS 75TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION.

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives respects the proud 1 history of the native Hawaiian people, recognizes the struggles 2 and hardships they have faced, and takes great pleasure and 3 pride in honoring their achievements; and 4 5 WHEREAS, one of the most deeply-instilled core values in 6 Hawaiian culture is the understanding of and love for the 'aina, 7 or land, and the challenges native Hawaiians have faced 8 throughout our State's history to maintain homelands to which 9 they have an exclusive right have been daunting; and 10 11 WHEREAS, after a struggle lasting more than a decade, 12 Hawaiian Prince and United States Congressman, Jonah Kuhio 13 Kalanianaole successfully facilitated the passage of the 14 Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, which established a 15 permanent land base for the benefit and use of native Hawaiians; 16 and 17 18 WHEREAS, due to the relentless efforts of revered Hawaiians 19 like Thomas Maunupau Sr. and Princess Abigail Kawananakoa, the 20 PAPAKOLEA HAWAIIAN HOMESTEAD, comprised of the neighborhoods of 21 Papakolea, Kewalo, and Kalawahine Streamside, was recognized on 22 May 16, 1934, as one of the State's first Hawaiian Homelands 23 under the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920; and 24 25 WHEREAS, since its inception, the PAPAKOLEA HAWAIIAN 26 HOMESTEAD has served as a rare and special place where native 27 Hawaiians are encouraged to sustain and perpetuate their 28 culture, and this unique character has made Papakolea the home 29 for some of Hawaii's most prominent citizens, including musical 30

31 icons Genoa Keawe and Danny Kaleikini; and

WHEREAS, Papakolea community leaders have founded several 1 noteworthy organizations, including the Papakolea Community 2 Association, Kula no na Po'e Hawai'i, the Papakolea Community 3 Development Corporation, Kewalo Hawaiian Homestead Community 4 5 Association, and Kalawahine Streamside Association, that currently serve for the betterment of Papakolea residents with a 6 7 focus on family, unity, and aloha; and 8

9 WHEREAS, the struggle to establish, maintain, and improve this early Hawaiian Homestead for the past 75 years mirrors the 10 struggle of all native Hawaiians to improve their rights and 11 their quality of life across the State, and serves to prove to 12 13 the people that positive changes are possible when a community comes together to heal and rebuild; now, therefore, 14 15

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 17 of 2009, that this body hereby recognizes and commends the 18 PAPAKOLEA HAWAIIAN HOMESTEAD for its 75-year commitment to the 19 betterment of native Hawaiians, and extends its warmest aloha 20 and best wishes for continued success in continuing their close 21 -knit community for generations of families to come. 22 23
