A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE NATURAL ENERGY LABORATORY OF HAWAII AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 227D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 2 3 There is established the natural energy laboratory of Hawaii authority, which shall be a body corporate and politic 4 5 and an instrumentality and agency of the State. The authority shall be placed within the department of business, economic 6 7 development, and tourism for administrative purposes, pursuant 8 to section 26-35. The purpose of the natural energy laboratory 9 of Hawaii authority shall be to facilitate research, **10** development, and commercialization of natural energy resources 11 and ocean-related research, technology, and industry in Hawaii **12** and to engage in retail, commercial, or tourism activities that 13 will financially support that research, development, and 14 commercialization at a research and technology park in Hawaii. 15 Its duties shall include:

Establishing, managing, and operating facilities that

provide sites for:

1		(A)	Research and development;
2		(B)	Commercial projects and businesses utilizing
3			natural resources, such as ocean water or
4			<pre>geothermal energy;</pre>
5		(C)	Compatible businesses engaged in scientific and
6			technological investigations, or retail,
7			commercial, and tourism activities; and
8		(D)	Businesses or educational facilities that support
9			the primary projects and activities;
10	(2)	Providing support, utilities, and other services to	
11		facility tenants and government agencies;	
12	(3)	Maintaining the physical structure of the facilities;	
13	(4)	Promoting and marketing these facilities;	
14	(5)	Promoting and marketing the reasonable utilization of	
15		available natural resources;	
16	(6)	Supporting ocean research and technology development

- 1 their designated representatives, shall serve as ex officio,
- 2 voting members of the board. The tenants of the natural energy
- 3 laboratory of Hawaii authority shall elect two members to the
- 4 board from among the tenants of the authority, of which one
- 5 member shall serve a two-year term, and one member shall serve a
- 6 four year term. Each tenant shall be entitled to cast one vote
- 7 for each member position. The tenant members shall be recused
- 8 from voting on setting lease rents, water rates, or utility
- 9 rates, but may participate in discussions. The director of
- 10 business, economic development, and tourism shall serve as the
- 11 chairperson until such time as a chairperson is elected by the
- 12 board from the membership. The board shall elect other officers
- 13 as it deems necessary.
- 14 SECTION 2. The inaugural election for the two tenant
- 15 representative positions on the board of directors of the
- 16 natural energy laboratory of Hawaii authority shall be completed
- 17 by October 1, 2009.
- 18 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
