A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HUMANE TREATMENT OF PET ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 711-1109, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsections (1) and (2) to read as follows: 2 3 "(1) A person commits the offense of cruelty to animals in 4 the second degree if the person intentionally, knowingly, or 5 recklessly: 6 Overdrives, overloads, tortures, torments, beats, (a) 7 causes substantial bodily injury, or starves any 8 animal, or causes the overdriving, overloading, 9 torture, torment, beating, or starving of any animal[-**10** or deprives]; 11 (b) Deprives a pet animal of necessary sustenance or **12** causes such deprivation; 13 (c) Mutilates, poisons, or kills without need any [(b)] 14 animal other than insects, vermin, or other pests; 15 [(c)] (d) Keeps, uses, or in any way is connected with or 16 interested in the management of, or receives money for the admission of any person to, any place kept or used **17**
