### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EARLY LEARNING.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to clarify 2 provisions of the early learning system, established by Act 14, 3 Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2008 by: 4 (1) Authorizing the Hawaii Council of Mayors to name 5 designees for their two representatives on the early learning council; 7 (2) Changing the name of the keiki first steps trust fund 8 to the early learning council trust fund; and 9 (3) Specifying that moneys in the trust fund shall not 10 lapse at the end of the fiscal year. SECTION 2. Section 302L-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 12 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 13 The council shall consist of the following voting members: 14 15 (1) The superintendent of education or the 16 superintendent's designee;

SECTION 3. Section 302L-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 8 amended to read as follows: 9 "[+] §302L-5[+] [Keiki first steps] Early learning council 10 trust fund. There is established within the state treasury the [keiki first steps] early learning council trust fund, to be 11 12 administered by the early learning council, into which shall be deposited all moneys received by the council in the form of: 13 14 (1)Fees; 15 (2) Grants; 16 Donations; (3) Appropriations made by the legislature to the fund; 17 (4)18 and 19 Revenues regardless of their source, (5) 20 and earnings on moneys in the fund. Moneys in the fund shall be 21 used for the early learning system. Expenditures from the fund

may be made by the council without appropriation or allotment.
