A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL MEALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The intent of this Act is to modify the manner
2	in which school meal prices, including lunch and breakfast, are
3	determined. With the rising costs of food, fuel, and labor, the
4	department of education requires a better method of determining
5	the price of school meals. Currently, the cost of school lunch
6	is limited to one-half of the cost of preparing the lunch. This
7	Act provides the department of education with greater fiscal
8	flexibility in the preparation of meals by requiring the
9	department of set meal prices at not less than one-half of the
10	cost of preparing meals. The Act also defines "school meals".
11	SECTION 2. Section 302A-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12	amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
13	and to read as follows:
14	""School meals" means breakfast and lunch prepared and
15	served by a school cafeteria."
16	SECTION 3. Section 302A-404, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17	amended to read as follows:

    previous year's costs rounded to the nearest five cents;

    provided that the department by rule shall provide a lower rate

    or free [lunches] meals to children based on their economic
