## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 431:10A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- ${f 2}$  amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§431:10A- Chemotherapy services. (a) All individual
- 5 and group accident and health or sickness policies that include
- 6 coverage or benefits for the treatment of cancer shall provide
- 7 payment or reimbursement for oral chemotherapy drugs under the
- 8 same terms and conditions and at a rate calculated according to
- 9 the same methods as payment or reimbursement for intravenously
- 10 administered chemotherapy drugs.
- (b) For the purposes of this section:
- "Intravenous chemotherapy drugs" means a physician-
- 13 prescribed cancer treatment that is administered through
- 14 injection directly into the patient's circulatory system by a
- 15 physician, physician assistant, nurse practitioner, nurse, or
- 16 other medical personnel under the supervision of a physician and
- 17 in a hospital, medical office or other clinical setting.

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1	"Oral chemotherapy drugs" means a United States Food and
2	Drug Administration-approved, physician-prescribed cancer
3	treatment that is taken orally in the form of a tablet or
4	capsule and may be administered in a hospital, medical office,
5	or other clinical setting or may be delivered to the patient for
6	self-administration under the direction or supervision of a
7	physician outside of a hospital, medical office, or other
8	clinical setting."
9	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
