## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 431:10A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§431:10A- Chemotherapy services. (a) Notwithstanding
5	section 23-51, all individual and group accident and health or
6	sickness policies that include coverage or benefits for the
7	treatment of cancer shall provide payment or reimbursement for
8	all chemotherapy, including orally administered chemotherapy,
9	under the same terms and conditions and at a rate calculated
10	according to the same methods as payment or reimbursement for
11	intravenously administered chemotherapy.
12	(b) For the purposes of this section:
13	"Intravenously administered chemotherapy" means a
14	physician-prescribed cancer treatment that is administered
15	through injection directly into the patient's circulatory system
16	by a physician, physician assistant, nurse practitioner, nurse,

- 1 or other medical personnel under the supervision of a physician
- 2 and in a hospital, medical office, or other clinical setting.
- 3 "Oral chemotherapy" means a United States Food and Drug
- 4 Administration-approved, physician-prescribed cancer treatment
- 5 that is taken orally in the form of a tablet or capsule and may
- 6 be administered in a hospital, medical office, or other clinical
- 7 setting or may be delivered to the patient for self-
- 8 administration under the direction or supervision of a physician
- 9 outside of a hospital, medical office, or other clinical
- 10 setting."
- 11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Health Insurance; Coverage; Chemotherapy

## Description:

Requires health insurance providers to provide health insurance coverage for all chemotherapy treatment, including orally administered chemotherapy, under the same terms and conditions and at a rate calculated according to the same methods as payment or reimbursement for intravenously administered chemotherapy.
