A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TEACHER EDUCATION COORDINATING COMMITTEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that in the past several
- 2 years the teacher education coordinating committee has worked to
- 3 strengthen the efforts of all teacher education institutions in
- 4 Hawaii to prepare quality teachers for Hawaii's K-12 schools.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to support the efforts of the
- 6 teacher education coordinating committee by clarifying the
- 7 membership of the committee to ensure that all institutions that
- 8 are state-approved teacher education units have a representative
- 9 on the committee.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 304A-1202, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) There is created an advisory committee to be known as
- 13 the teacher education coordinating committee to identify, study,
- 14 take action, or make recommendations on matters of education of
- 15 common interest to the department of education and institutions
- 16 of higher learning in Hawaii. The membership of the committee
- 17 shall include the superintendent of education and the dean of

- 1 the college of education of the University of Hawaii, who shall
- 2 serve in alternate years as chairperson of the committee with
- 3 the superintendent acting as the first chairperson, a
- 4 representative from each accredited [teacher training
- 5 institution in Hawaii, Hawaii state-approved teacher education
- 6 unit, and a representative from the Hawaii teacher standards
- 7 board. In addition, the superintendent of education and the
- 8 dean of the college of education may each appoint other members
- 9 to the committee; provided that the dean of the college of
- 10 education shall appoint at least two members of the committee
- 11 from the university who are not within the college of
- 12 education."
- 13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
