
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO REAL PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to enable the
2 counties to promptly track ownership, encumbrances,
3 restrictions, uses, and sales prices of real property for the
4 purposes of determining more accurate real property tax
5 assessments.

6 This Act requires the registrar of the bureau of
7 conveyances to provide the administrator of the real property
8 assessment division of the city and county of Honolulu with an
9 image and index of all documents relating to the regular system
10 land that have been recorded. With this information, the city
11 and county of Honolulu real property assessment division
12 administrator will act as a central clearinghouse and provide
13 copies of the images to the real property assessment
14 administrators of the other counties.

15 SECTION 2. Section 502-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 **"§502-26 Copies of instruments, certificates. (a)** The
18 registrar, when applied to, shall furnish an attested copy of

1 any instrument or document recorded in the registrar's office,
2 or of any fact appearing upon the registrar's records. The
3 registrar may also issue nonattested portions of any instrument
4 or document recorded in the registrar's office. The registrar
5 may issue certificates of search or [~~incumbrance~~] encumbrance
6 when personnel is available for the making of the certificate.

7 (b) Within ten days after the end of each week, or as soon
8 thereafter as possible, the assistant registrar, without charge,
9 shall deliver or forward by mail to the real property assessment
10 administrator of the city and county of Honolulu, an image and
11 index of all instruments or documents relating to land in all
12 the counties that have been recorded in the registrar's office
13 during the past week. The index shall include the following for
14 each instrument:

15 (1) Document number;

16 (2) Certificate number;

17 (3) Date of the filing;

18 (4) Type of document;

19 (5) Grantor and grantee;

20 (6) Current tax map key number; and

21 (7) Location by island.

1 The real property assessment administrator of the city and
2 county of Honolulu shall provide copies of the images, without
3 charge, to the real property assessment administrators of the
4 other counties. The registrar may impose a charge, pursuant to
5 rules adopted under chapter 91, to provide images or other
6 information to parties other than the counties."

7 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Requires the registrar of the bureau of conveyances to provide, within 10 days and free of charge, an image and index of all instruments that contain real property transactions each week to the administrator of the city and county of Honolulu's real property assessment division. (SD2)
