### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGH TECHNOLOGY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 206M-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended as follows:
3	1. By amending subsection (b) to read:
4	"(b) The development corporation [may] shall provide

17	"(d)	If funds appropriated for the purpose of making

20	apply for	funds to be transferred [from the Hawaii capital loan	
21	<del>revolving</del>	fund] to provide the grants in accordance with	
22	subsectio	n (b). The amount of any single transfer of funds	
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1 shall not exceed \$100,000, and the development corporation shall 2 transfer the entire amount back [to the Hawaii capital loan 3 revolving fund] within twelve months of receiving the funds. No more than one fund transfer shall be outstanding at any one 4 5 time. The director of business, economic development, and 6 tourism may transfer funds [from the Hawaii capital loan 7 revolving fund] to the development corporation upon request to 8 carry out the purposes of this section. Transfers of funds 9 shall be made without any charges or fees." 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

#### Report Title:

Small Business Innovation

### Description:

Clarifies the operation of the high technology research and development loan and grant program to allow the State to catch up to increased federal award amounts. Provides that the High Technology Development Corporation shall provide a grant to any small business in Hawaii that receives federal small business innovative research or technology transfer awards.
