A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIMITING CIVIL LIABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§663- Owner to criminal offender; limited liability.
5	(a) An owner, including a public entity, of any interest in
6	real property shall not be liable for any injury to a person
7	that occurs upon the real property during the course of the
8	person's commission of a criminal offense; provided that:
9	(1) The injured person is charged with the criminal
10	offense, and convicted of the criminal offense or of a
11	lesser included felony or misdemeanor; and
12	(2) The injured person's conduct in furtherance of the
13	commission of the criminal offense, or lesser included
14	felony or misdemeanor, proximately causes the injury.
15	(b) During the pendency of a criminal proceeding under
16	subsection (a)(1), a civil action alleging the owner's liability

1	for the pe	erson's injury shall be abated and the statute of
2	limitation	ns on the civil cause of action shall be tolled.
3	(c)	This section shall not limit the liability of an owner
4	or an owne	er's agent that otherwise exists for wilful, wanton, or
5	criminal o	conduct, or for wilful failure to guard or warn against
6	a dangerou	us condition, use, or structure.
7	(d)	The limitation on liability provided by this section
8	shall be	in addition to any other available defense.
9	<u>(e)</u>	For the purposes of this section, "criminal offense"
10	means:	
11	(1)	Murder in the first or second degree;
12	(2)	Attempted murder;
13	(3)	Any class A felony enumerated in the Hawaii penal
14		code, including any attempt or conspiracy to commit a
15		crime classified as a class A felony;
16	(4)	Any class B felony enumerated in the Hawaii penal
17		code, including any attempt or conspiracy to commit a
18		<pre>crime classified as a class B felony;</pre>
19	(5)	Any felony punishable by imprisonment by the State for
20		<pre>life;</pre>
21	(6)	Any other felony in which the defendant inflicts
22		serious bodily injury on any person, other than an

1		accomplice, or any felony in which the defendant uses
2		a firearm; or
3	(7)	Any felony in which the defendant uses a dangerous or
