A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AEROSPACE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§201- Aerospace advisory committee. (a) There is
5	established an aerospace advisory committee within the office of
6	aerospace development of the department of business, economic
7	development, and tourism for administrative purposes. The
. 8	committee shall be composed of sixteen members appointed by the
9	governor, as provided in section 26-34, except as otherwise
10	provided in this section.
11,	(b) All members shall serve for a term of two years. Any
12	vacancies occurring in the membership of the committee shall be
13	filled for the remainder of the unexpired term in the same
14	manner as the original appointments. Of the sixteen members:
15	(1) Three members shall be representatives of the national
16	aerospace industry;

1	(2)	Three members shall be representatives of the
2		aerospace industry in the State;
3	<u>(3)</u>	One member shall be a representative of investment
4		banking;
5	(4)	Four members shall be representatives of the economic
6		development boards of Kauai, Oahu, Maui, and Hawaii,
7		respectively;
8	(5)	Four members shall be representatives of education,
9		specifically the department of education, the
10		University of Hawaii at Manoa, the University of
11		Hawaii at Hilo, and the community college system,
12		respectively; and
13	(6)	One member shall serve as chairperson and shall have
14		experience, knowledge, and expertise in space-related
15		activities and development in the global and state
16		aerospace industry.
17	(c)	The governor shall appoint:
18	(1)	One representative of the national aerospace industry
19		and one representative of aerospace industry in the
20		State from a list of nominees submitted by the
21		president of the senate, and one representative of the
22		national aerospace industry and one representative of

I		aerospace industry in the State from a list of
2		nominees submitted by the speaker of the house of
3		representatives;
4	(2)	One representative of the national aerospace industry,
5		one representative of aerospace industry in the State,
6		one representative of investment banking, and one
7		representative who shall serve as chairperson, as
8		<pre>provided in subsection (a)(6);</pre>
9	(3)	Four representatives of the county economic
10		development boards, with one representative each
11		appointed from a list of nominees submitted by each
12		county economic development board, respectively; and
13	(4)	Four representatives of the education sector, with one
14		representative each appointed from a list of nominees
15		submitted by each of the following: department of
16		education, the University of Hawaii at Manoa, the
17		University of Hawaii at Hilo, and the community
18		college system, respectively.
19	<u>(d)</u>	The purpose of the aerospace advisory committee shall
20	be to adv	ise and assist the legislature and the state agencies
21	in monitor	ring, assessing, and promoting aerospace development

1	(1)	Tracking state, national, and global trends and
2		priorities in aerospace development;
3	(2)	Assisting in identifying and promoting opportunities
4		to expand and diversify aerospace development and
5		aerospace-related industries in the State;
6	(3)	Supporting the office of aerospace development's
7		effort in networking with national and international
8		aerospace agencies, institutions, and organizations to
9		develop public-private partnerships to support the
10		growth of aerospace development and aerospace-related
11		industries in the State;
12	(4)	Recommending innovative scientific, educational, and
13		economic strategies and government and education
14		policies to promote the growth and diversification of
15		the aerospace industry in the State; and
16	(5)	Appointing temporary working groups, as deemed
17		appropriate in the committee's discretion, to assist
18		the office of aerospace development in research and
19		analysis activities required to complete any report to
20	,	be submitted to the legislature and the governor by
21		the office of aerospace development.

1	(e) Members of the aerospace advisory committee shall
2	receive no compensation, but shall be reimbursed for necessary
3	expenses, including travel expenses, incurred in the performance
4	of their duties as a committee member.
5	(f) The committee shall convene for quarterly meetings in
6	the city and county of Honolulu; provided that any member who is
7	not a state resident may attend a meeting by teleconference.
8	(g) Administrative support to the committee, including the
9	development and dissemination of reports and advisory opinions,
10	shall be provided by the department of business, economic
11	development, and tourism."
12	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
13	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
