BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 36-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

3	"(b)	Not later than January 1, 2009, the department of
4	budget an	d finance, in accordance with this section, shall
5	establish	, implement, and maintain a single searchable website,
6	accessibl	e by the public at no cost, that includes for each
7	state awa	rd:
8	(1)	The name of the entity receiving the award;
9	(2)	The amount of the award;
10	(3)	Information on the award, including transaction type,
11		funding agency, [the North American Industry
12		Classification System code,] program source, and an
13		award title descriptive of the purpose of each funding
14		action;
15	(4)	The full address of the entity receiving the award and
16		the primary location of performance under the award;



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1	(5) A unique identifier of the entity receiving the award		
2	and of the parent entity of the recipient, if the		
3	entity is owned by another entity; and		
4	(6) Any other relevant information specified by the		
5	department of budget and finance.		
6	The website shall include data for fiscal year 2008 and		
7	each fiscal year thereafter.		
8	The director of finance is authorized to designate one or		
9	more state agencies to participate in the development,		
10	establishment, maintenance, and support of the website[\cdot]:		
11	provided that the department of accounting and general services,		
12	in collaboration with the department of budget and finance, is		
13	responsible for collecting and posting on the website, the		
14	information that is required by this subsection. In the initial		
15	designation, or in subsequent instructions and guidance, the		
16	director may specify the scope of the responsibilities of each		
17	agency.		
18	State agencies shall comply with the instructions and		
19	guidance issued by the director of finance and shall provide		
20	appropriate assistance to the director upon request, so as to		
21	assist the director in ensuring the existence and operation of
