RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 3 "(C) Length: 4 No single motor vehicle or other power vehicle having (1)5 a total overall length greater than forty-five feet, 6 including load, shall be operated or moved upon any 7 public road, street, or highway within the [State,] 8 state, except as provided in this subsection; 9 (2)No truck-tractor and semitrailer having a total 10 overall length greater than sixty-five feet, including 11 load, shall be operated or moved upon any public road, street, or highway, other than interstate highways and **12** 13 certain qualifying federal aid highways as designated

12		least seven feet above the roadway surface;
