BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

The plan shall be directed toward the 8 ultimate development of a balanced, multi-modal statewide 9 transportation system that serves clearly identified social, 10 economic, and environmental objectives.
