## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§286-</u> Complete streets. (a) The department of
5	transportation and the county transportation departments shall
6	adopt a complete streets policy that seeks to reasonably
7	accommodate convenient access and mobility for all users of the
8	public highways and trails system within developments as defined
9	in section 264-121 that are in their respective jurisdiction as
10	described under section 264-1, including pedestrians,
11	bicyclists, transit users, motorists, and persons of all ages
12	and abilities.
13	(b) This section shall apply to new construction,
14	reconstruction, and maintenance of highways, roads, streets,
15	ways, and lanes located within urban, suburban, and rural areas,
16	if appropriate for the application of complete streets.
