SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO CONVENE A STATEWIDE TASK FORCE TO ADVISE THE LEGISLATURE ON METHODS TO IMPROVE HAWAII'S MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the National Alliance on Mental Illness has 1 2 published "A Report on America's Health Care System for Adults with Serious Mental Illness" which includes a State Report Card 3 for each state; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Hawaii received the grade of "C" for the State's 6 7 mental health care system; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Hawaii's State Report Card notes that, "Hawaii's mental health care system has improved substantially 10 since . . . the 1980s and early 1990s, but the state is now at 11 12 risk of sliding backward"; and 13 WHEREAS, during times of economic crisis, mental health 14 15 services are needed more urgently and yet budget cuts put the State's provision of mental health services at risk; and 16 17 18 WHEREAS, many mental illnesses are treatable; and 19 20 WHEREAS, many people with mental illness are hospitalized, live on the streets, are in jail, or die needlessly; now, 21 22 therefore, 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fifth 24 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2009, 25 that the Legislature requests the Department of Human Services 26 to convene a statewide Task Force of stakeholders to advise the 27 Legislature on methods to improve Hawaii's mental health 28 services; and 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Force of stakeholders 31 is requested to use "A Report on America's Health Care System 32 for Adults with Serious Mental Illness" and Hawaii's State 33 Report Card to glean methods to improve Hawaii's mental health 34 35 services; and
