begs leave to report as follows:

Testimony in support of the nomination of Olivia B. Nagashima was submitted by the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, the Massage Therapists Association of Hawaii, the Hawaiian Islands School of Massage, and two private citizens. Testimony in support of the nomination of Wendee J. Wilson was submitted by the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and one private citizen.
