Your Committee on Commerce and Consumer Protection, to which
was referred H.B. No. 1414, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO METAL,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to make permanent the
prohibition against stealing beer kegs and the documentation
requirements for scrap metal dealers contained in Act 53, Session
Laws of Hawaii 2008.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of the Attorney General, the Department of the
Prosecuting Attorney of the City and County of Honolulu, Hawaiian
Electric Company, and Anheuser Busch Companies. Written testimony
presented to the Committee may be reviewed on the Legislature's
website.


Current law establishing a misdemeanor offense for the theft
of beer kegs and imposing certain record-keeping requirements on
scrap metal dealers includes a provision to repeal the Act
creating the law on July 1, 2009. Your Committee finds that the
prohibitions and record-keeping requirements contained in the
current law have proven effective at deterring theft of beer kegs
and merit permanence.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Commerce and Consumer Protection that is attached to
this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and



purpose of H.B. No. 1414, H.D. 1, and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Government Operations.
