Your Committees on Health and Education, to which was referred H.B. No. 1538 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE PRODUCTS,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to ensure the health and safety of public school students by:

- (1) Requiring the Department of Education (DOE) to use environmentally-sensitive cleaning and maintenance products (Products);
- (2) Directing the Department of Health (DOH) to establish guidelines and specifications for the Products; and
- (3) Requiring the State Procurement Office (SPO) to maintain a list of vendors where Products are available.

DOE, several students from Moanalua High School and Kawaiaha'o School, and several concerned individuals supported this bill.

DOH and SPO opposed this measure. The American Chemistry Council and Consumer Specialty Products Association submitted comments.


