Your Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 221 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, BOARD OF VETERINARY EXAMINERS AND THE HAWAIIAN HUMANE SOCIETY TO IMPLEMENT A COMPREHENSIVE PET PROTECTION PROGRAM FOR DOGS AND CATS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to request that the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, the Board of Veterinary Examiners and the Hawaiian Humane Society implement a comprehensive pet protection program for dogs and cats. This program would require that all pet dealers furnish a complete medical history to a buyer upon the purchase of a dog or cat. Additionally, these pet dealers would be required to refund the purchase price or pay medical expenses to a customer who has purchased a pet that has a fatal or life threatening disease.

Testimony in support of the concurrent resolution was submitted by The Humane Society of the United States, Animal Rights Hawai'i, the Hawaiian Humane Society, the Oahu Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals and private citizens. Testimony in opposition was submitted by the American Kennel Club and concerned exhibitors and breeders from various clubs. The Professional and Vocational Licensing Division of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and the Board of Veterinary Examiners provided comments.
