Your Committee on Economic Revitalization, Business, & Military Affairs, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 49 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING FULL PRESERVATION OF UNITED STATES MARINE CORPS AIR STATION EWA AS A NATIONAL MONUMENT, MUSEUM, AND RESTORED PARK FOR THE STATE OF HAWAII, "

- (6) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

No. 49, as amended herein, and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Water, Land, & Ocean Resources in the form attached hereto as H.C.R. No. 49, H.D. 1.
