## Sir:

Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 564, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO FIRE PROTECTION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to clarify fire inspection laws by:

- Clarifying that the county fire chiefs or their (1)designees are authorized to inspect all buildings and facilities, except state-owned airport facilities, and not only those that are state-owned or county-owned; and
- Requiring fire safety inspections at least once every (2)five years or as often as practicable or necessary instead of every two years for all buildings other than public schools.

The State Fire Council, Honolulu Fire Department, Hawaii Fire Department, and Hawaii Association of Independent Schools supported this bill.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

Changing the effective date to July 1, 2020, to encourage further discussion; and
