SB 1623 RELATING TO FORECLOSURES. CPN, JGO

Testimony

Requires mortgagors and mortgagees to explore options to avoid foreclosure, including modification or restructuring of loans; effective on approval and repeals 12/31/2012. Requires notice of foreclosure be given to a tenant of the foreclosed property with the option to keep

rental agreement in full force or vacate premises in 60 days.

SB 1328 RELATING TO FORECLOSURES. CPN, JGO

Testimony

Grants owner-occupants of residential real property the right to engage in mediation with a mortgagee in order to prevent foreclosure of the

<u>Status</u> residential property. Establishes notice requirements.

SB 1218 RELATING TO MORTGAGE LOAN ORIGINATORS. CPN, WAM

Allows the commissioner of financial institutions to regulate, license, examine, and enforce laws regulating mortgage brokers and loan

<u>Status</u> originators. Repeals chapter 454.

SB 1606 RELATING TO REAL ESTATE APPRAISAL MANAGEMENT CPN, JGO

Testimony COMPANIES.

Provides for registration of real estate appraisal management companies with the real estate commission of the department of

commerce and consumer affairs. Establishes standards and violations.

SB 1230 RELATING TO TAXATION. CPN, WAM

Authorizes a tax on the transfer in ownership of a legal entity when the selling entity owns real property in Hawaii that is acquired by another

Status individual or entity through the purchasing of an interest in the selling

entity.

SB 1106 RELATING TO TAXATION. CPN, WAM

Testimony

Requires a buyer of real property located in Hawaii to furnish to the bureau of conveyances a tax clearance certificate issued from the department of taxation that certifies that the HARPTA withholding

requirements were satisfied as a condition to recording a change in title

on the real property.

SB 1165 RELATING TO GENERAL EXCISE TAX. CPN, WAM

Testimony Makes the GET exemption amendments for timeshare operators and

condominium submanagers permanent.

SB 1107 RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS. CPN, WAM

Testimony Merges the condominium management education fund and the

condominium education trust fund.

**Status** 

SB 850 RELATING TO NOTARY PUBLIC SEALS. CPN, JGO

Testimony Requires a notary public to include on the notary public's stamp or seal

the notary public's commission number.

**Status**
