SB 1671 RELATING TO FOSSIL FUELS.

<u>Testimony</u> Prohibits the approval of any new electricity generating facilities using

fossil fuel and the modification of existing electricity generating

facilities to allow the use of more fossil fuel.

SB 1675, SD1 RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY.

<u>Testimony</u> Removes the capacity limit for net energy metering and increases

eligible customer-generator capacity to one megawatt. Permits existing net metered customers to remain with net metering program once alternative credits or compensation mechanisms are created. Allows an eligible customer-generator to generate up to one hundred kilowatts before the eligible customer-generator must gain public utilities commission approval of safety and performance standards.
