SB 1161 RELATING TO LOW INCOME HOUSING TAX CREDIT. EDH, WAM

Clarifies the term "credit period" for the purposes of the low income housing tax credit.

SB 1118 RELATING TO LOW-INCOME HOUSING. EDH, WAM

Testimony
Provides additional incentives for the development of affordable housing by increasing the low-income housing tax credit from a one-time credit of fifty per cent to a one hundred per cent credit taken over

five years.

SB 184 RELATING TO TAX CREDITS. EDH, WAM

Testimony Reduces the period over which state low-income housing tax credits

are taken from 10 years to 5 years.

SB 278 RELATING TO LOW-INCOME HOUSING. EDH, WAM

Testimony Enhances the low-income housing tax credit along the lines of the high

technology business investment tax credit.

SB 188 RELATING TO HOUSING. EDH, WAM

Testimony Requires a percentage of state conveyance and excise taxes to be paid

into the rental housing trust fund.

SB 1294 RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING. EDH, WAM

Testimony
Appropriates funds for the purpose of expenditures by the Hawaii public housing authority to make required repairs and renovations at public housing facilities to ensure compliance with state and federal

law.

SB 755 RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT EDH, WTL

Testimony AUTHORITY.

Authorizes the Hawaii community development authority to process an application for subdivision and consolidation of land for a planned

development project with at least twenty per cent of the total number of dwelling units in the project reserved for sale or rental to qualified

persons as determined by the authority.
