HB 172 RELATING TO RECONSTITUTING SCHOOLS. EDN/LAB, FIN

Allows the Superintendent of Education to reconstitute a public school, except a charter school, which has been in restructuring for three or more school years. Also allows the Superintendent to recommend to the charter school review panel actions that should be taken to reconstitute a charter school which has been in restructuring for three

or more school years, and recommend that the charter school review

panel revoke the charter school's charter.

HB 174 RELATING TO SALARY RANGES FOR TEACHERS. EDN/LAB, FIN

Status Repeals statutory provisions establishing salary ranges for teachers that

are no longer applicable.

HB 175 Status	RELATING TO SALARY INCREASES FOR TEACHERS AND EDUCATIONAL OFFICERS. Repeals the statutory provisions that provide teachers and educational officers with annual incremental or longevity step increases.	EDN/LAB, FIN
HB 177 Status	RELATING TO CAUSES FOR DISCHARGE OR DEMOTION OF TEACHERS. Repeals the statute providing for the demotion of teachers.	EDN/LAB, FIN
HB 178 Status	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. Repeals the statute providing for district business and fiscal officers of the Department of Education.	EDN/LAB, FIN
HB 183 Status	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Authorizes the Hawaii teacher standards board to suspend its policies, rules, and standards when required by extenuating circumstances. Authorizes the board to determine how it collects license fees.	EDN/LAB, FIN
HB 184 Status	RELATING TO TEACHER EDUCATION COORDINATING COMMITTEE. Amends the membership of the teacher education coordinating committee to include a representative of each state approved teacher education program.	EDN/LAB, FIN
HB 541 Status	RELATING TO CIVIL SERVICE PERSONNEL. Ensures that civil service benefits for department of education civil service employees are the same as those provided to civil service employees of other executive branch employees until 6/30/12.	EDN/LAB, FIN (pending re-referral to EDN/LAB, FIN)
HB 938 Status	RELATING TO CAFETERIA WORKERS. Changes the employment period for cafeteria workers employed on or after July 1, 2009, from twelve to ten months.	EDN/LAB, FIN
HB 1082 Status	RELATING TO THE SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, AND MATH INCOME TAX CREDIT. Provides an income tax credit for donations made to a qualifying science, technology, engineering, and math academy certified by the department of business, economic development, and tourism.	EDN/HED, EBM, FIN
HB 1690 Status	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Clarifies that teachers hired on an emergency hire basis are required to demonstrate active pursuit of a teacher's license in each year of their employment as teachers over a maximum of four years.	EDN/LAB, FIN
