<u>SB 954</u> RELATING TO PHOTOGRAPHS OF HISTORIC BUILDINGS. EDT

<u>Testimony</u>

Changes the requirement for archival photographs for permits allowing the demolition, construction, or other alteration of a historic building to photographs in any format, including electronic, for buildings eligible for listing on the Hawaii or National Register of Historic Places.

SB 787 RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION. EDT

<u>Testimony</u> Changes the requirement for archival photographs for permits allowing

the demolition, construction, or other major alteration of a historic building to photographs in any format. Provides that if the State Historic Preservation Division does not act upon a plan submission

within 30 days, the proposal is treated as accepted.

SB 66 RELATING TO THE BOXING COMMISSION. EDT, CPN
