SB 811 Testimony Status	RELATING TO ENERGY RESOURCES Requires all new state buildings and facilities for which construction commences after 1/1/10, to have no less than 10% of electricity usage supplied by renewable energy.	ENE/JGO, WAM
SB 559 Testimony Status	RELATING TO RECYCLING. Directs the department of accounting and general services to establish by 01/01/11 a mandatory recycling program for all state buildings and facilities, public schools, and the University of Hawaii.	ENE/JGO, WAM
