HB 1289, HD1 (HSCR192) Status	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT Requires all offerors and subcontractors for construction contracts subject to the state public procurement code, to maintain or participate in a bona fide, state-approved apprenticeship program at the time of general bidding for a period of not less than 6 months.	LAB, FIN
HB 826, HD1 (HSCR355) Status	RELATING TO PUBLIC WORKS. Establishes requirements for contractors who bid on state construction projects. Establishes penalties for non-compliance with such requirements.	LAB, FIN
<u>HB 643, HD2</u> (<u>HSCR377)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO CONTRACTORS. Authorizes the Contractors License Board to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew a contractor's license for employing a worker on a public work project who is ineligible to work in the United States under federal law.	LAB, JUD, FIN
HB 1676 (HSCR360) Status	RELATING TO PUBLIC WORKS. Requires that the collective bargaining agreement be submitted to the director of labor and industrial relations in order for the terms in the agreement to dictate the prevailing wages with regard to a project financed through the issuance of a special purpose revenue bond.	LAB, FIN



HB 1479, HD1 (HSCR362) Status	RELATING TO LABOR. Requires a certified copy of a fringe benefit reporting form supplied by the department of labor and industrial relations to be submitted weekly to the governmental contracting agency for review on public works projects. Requires an an itemized list of fringe benefit costs paid for each employee by the general contractor or subcontractor to laborers and mechanics on public works projects.	LAB, FIN
HB 952 (HSCR143) Status	RELATING TO LABOR. Certifies entities as exclusive representatives absent an election where no other representatives are certified as the exclusive bargaining representatives. Requires immediate collective bargaining between parties once entities are certified as exclusive representatives.	LAB, FIN
