Governor Lingle's Financial Plan

On January 9, 2009, the Council on Revenues reduced revenue projections for fiscal year 2009, 2010, and 2011. As a result of the revised revenue projections, the projected budget shortfall will increase by about \$630 million. This brings the total projected revenue shortfall to \$1.8 billion by June 30, 2011 (the end of fiscal year 2011).

Budget Director, Georgina Kawamura, will brief the Joint Committee on the Governor's revised financial plan to meet this revised budget shortfall.
