Testimony PROHIBITION.

Makes compliance with smoking restriction law by nightclubs and restaurants a condition of renewal for a liquor license. Authorizes the

liquor commission to enforce smoking laws, concurrently with the department of health. Increases fines for violation of smoking restriction law. Requires revocation of liquor license for third

violation of smoking law.

#### SB 472 RELATING TO LANDFILLS. HTH/TIA, JGO

Testimony

Transfers regulation of private landfills from the counties to the department of health; establishes a private landfill permit program

<u>Status</u> administered by the department of health.
