HB 50 RELATING TO FAMILY COURTS. HUS, JUD, FIN Status Requires a minor adjudicated of actions that would constitute promoting a controlled substance to choose either detention in youth correctional facility or substance abuse counseling program with parents or legal guardians. HUS, JUD, FIN HB 297 RELATING TO THE INTERSTATE COMPACT FOR JUVENILES. Adopts the new Interstate Compact for Juveniles and establishes the Status family court's jurisdiction under the compact. HB 726 RELATING TO CHILDREN. HUS, JUD, FIN Status Establishes a task force to examine situations resulting in a child fatality or a serious injury due to drug use by a parent, guardian, or caregiver, and develop a plan to prevent such situations from occurring. Establishes a system for the Department of Human Services to allow children to continue to reside in pre-existing caregivers' safe homes rather than enter into foster care, subject to certain conditions. HUS, JUD, FIN HB 728 RELATING TO TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDERS. Requires the judiciary to establish a three-year statewide pilot project Status for the electronic filing of requests for and issuance of domestic abuse temporary restraining orders on nights and weekends.
