HB 88 RELATING TO AMMUNITION. PBS, JUD, FIN

Status Requires all ammunition of a specified caliber manufactured or sold in Hawaii that is capable of use in handguns, including assault pistols, to

be coded to assist law enforcement in identifying and prosecuting gun crime offenders. Requires Attorney General to establish a statewide

database to track coded ammunition. Effective 7/1/2009.

<u>HB .16</u> RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. PBS, AGR, FIN

Status Establishes a temporary reimbursement program for tenants of state

agricultural lands in vog-impacted areas to reimburse tenants for costs of repair and maintenance of fencing and other infrastructure repair

and maintenance.

HB 312 RELATING TO HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES. PBS, HLT FIN

Status Directs the Department of Defense to develop and implement a

program to ensure that an adequate number of monitors to detect sulfur dioxide are strategically placed throughout areas of the state where

high incidences of vog, sulfur dioxide, or both occur.
