Directs the legislative reference bureau to review the memorandum of understanding between the department of education and the department of budget and finance for the allotment of capital improvement projects, for the purpose of replicating the processes of the memorandum of understanding for usage by other state agencies.	WAM
SB 646 Testimony Status	RELATING TO PUBLIC ACCOUNTABILITY. Amends the governor's power to unilaterally limit appropriations that were previously approved by the legislature to require the governor to explain in writing any decisions to limit appropriations approved by the legislature.	WAM
SB 1197 Testimony Status	RELATING TO THE ECONOMY. Requires the department of taxation to provide an annual report on tax expenditures to the legislature on or before September 15th of each odd-numbered year.	WAM
SB 1327 Testimony Status	RELATING TO THE RATE OF INTEREST APPLICABLE TO OVERPAYMENTS OF TAX. Amends the current interest rate payable on overpayments of tax to the rate of one-third of one per cent for each month or fraction thereof.	WAM
