(SSCR593) Permits the use of deadly force by the resident of a dwelling against a person not lawfully in the dwelling

who uses force against the resident. Expands the exemption from the duty to retreat from the home and workplace to any place where the actor may lawfully be

(SSCR589) Limits the civil liability of property owners for damages to Status persons injured or killed on premises while committing
