- 1 Department's Position: The department respectfully opposes this measure. Given current fiscal
- 2 difficulties, it would not be prudent to enact the measure now.
- 3 Fiscal Implications: As yet, un-quantified resources would be needed to adopt and enforce rules.
- 4 Purpose and Justification: The bill amends section 342F-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to require the
- 5 director to establish rules requiring the use of mufflers on yard equipment.
  - We generally favor a quieter environment. We appreciate that some people dislike noisy leaf
- blowers/yard equipment. Noise can be a nuisance and disturb sleep, even if it does not reach the levels
- 8 that cause hearing damage. There are also practical considerations in achieving a quieter environment.
  - Any new mandate will require additional resources for the adoption of rules and serious
- 10 enforcement.

- The proposal will not result in significant noise reduction. Landscaping equipment in use is generally equipped with original equipment manufactured mufflers. Mufflers for small engines do not
