Subject: House Bill 1436, HD1, SD1 Relating to Agriculture

The Department of Planning and Permitting (DPP) has **comments** on House Bill No. 1436, HD1, SD1, which would allow agricultural education programs as a permitted use within the state agricultural district, on soils classified by the land study bureau as overall (master) productivity rating A or B, and defines "agricultural education programs."

We continue to have serious reservations about outright allowing educational programs on a farming operation, even as an accessory use. Without a permit review process we cannot determine whether the use would interfere with surrounding farm operations. Educational programs on agricultural lands should only be allowed through the approval of a special permit (Section 205-6, HRS), which would allow for case-specific evaluation and analyses. Through such a public review before the Planning Commission, impacts on surrounding property, public infrastructure, such as water, wastewater, drainage, traffic and public services such as fire and ambulance, can be thoroughly evaluated and addressed.
