The Council supports provisions that require information to determine the qualifications of nonprofit and for-profit entities to be awarded health care insurance contracts. We have been working with representatives from FACE (Faith Action for Community Equity), HMSA, and others to amend this bill in a form that we can agree with as the basis for continued discussion during the interim period after the 2009 and prior to the 2010 legislative sessions.

The passage of this bill will provide a mechanism for the group to continue discussion and work toward achieving transparency in future Request for Proposal, and award and implementation of health insurance contracts.
