There is NO NEED to add another expensive system (in time and money) to the existing means of including traditional mana'o to resource management in Hawai'i. We need to use the one we have, OHA.

This bill seeks to implant conflicting interests in our communities by hiding behind the Hawaiians.

For our family, we do not need the aha ahupua'a, aha moku or aha kiole to do what needs to be done. The systems are in place and the laws are clear. We just have to use them.
