**Purpose of Bill:** 

Requires the Director of Transportation to conduct a statewide pupil travel evaluation to study how students get to school and use the information obtained from the evaluation to provide Safe Routes to School program funds for school-based workshops and community-based planning projects that will reduce vehicular travel and congestion, encourage walking and bicycling, and promote health and safety. Requires the Director to develop a streamlined process for the federal Safe Routes to School grant program
