Department's Position:	The Department of Education (DOE) does not support HCR 151.
	The DOE respectfully informs the committee that it has complied with the
	provisions of Section 89-9, as it pertains to periodic repricing reviews.
	Section 89-9(f)(2), Hawaii Revised Statutes, states: "If repricing has not
	been negotiated, the employer of each jurisdiction shall ensure
	establishment of procedures to periodically review, at least once in five
	years,the repricing of classes within the bargaining unit. The repricing
	of classes based on the results of the periodic review shall be at the
	discretion of the employer." The provision took effect on July 1, 2002, so
	the first five-year period ended on June 30, 2007.
	The DOE completed its first periodic repricing review and notified the
	Superintendent in a memorandum dated June 27, 2007. As a new
	jurisdiction, the department did not take any repricing actions in the initial
	five-year period. However, since then we have repriced the following civil
	service class:
	Offset Press Operator IV, repriced from WS08 to WS09.

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The following classes are exempt from civil service under Section

76-16(b)(11)(B), HRS, and were repriced through negotiations with the union:

Educational Assistant I, repriced from SR06 to SR08

Educational Assistant II, repriced from SR08 to SR10

Educational Assistant III, repriced from SR10 to SR12

Although there is no reporting requirement in the law, the DOE provides notification of its repricing actions to other personnel jurisdictions of the state and counties to ensure equitqable compensation for civil service employees.
