Chair Cabanilla and Members of the Committee:

I am Ken H. Takayama, Director of the Legislative Reference Bureau. Thank you for this opportunity to testify on House Concurrent Resolution No. 205. The Bureau takes **no position** either for or against the measure, but offers the following **comments** and requests that the measure be **amended**.

- 1. This measure, among other things, directs the Bureau to:
 - a. Study the establishment of a veterans' preference in affordable housing <u>and other state and county programs;</u>
 - Review criteria for extending the preference to widows and widowers of certain veterans.
- 2. To the extent that this measure directs a study of veterans' preference in affordable housing programs, we believe the study requested is manageable.
- 3. However, the Concurrent Resolution <u>also</u> directs the study to encompass <u>"other state and county programs"</u>. This requires the study to include all state and county programs, which makes the scope of the study impossibly broad.
- 4. We therefore request that the measure be amended to:
 - a. Limit its scope to a veterans' preference in affordable housing; and
 - b. Delete any references to "other state and county programs".
