In consideration of **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 250 –** REOUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO REVIEW ALL BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, COUNCILS, COMMITTEES, WORKING GROUPS. AND TASK FORCES TO DETERMINE WHICH OF THESE CAN BE **ELIMINATED**

House Concurrent Resolution 250 requests the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) to review the possible elimination of boards, commissions, councils, committees, working groups, and task forces that have completed their tasks or become ineffective or dysfunctional. While the Department appreciates the intent of this resolution, given the uncertainties of the fiscal situation, the impact on the Department's operating budget, the need to direct new efforts to apply for federal stimulus grants, which will come with additional reporting requirements, the Department's personnel and fiscal resources are being spread thin. As an alternative, this Committee might consider requesting the Boards and Commission staff of the Office of the Governor to take on the review as called for in this resolution, since this is a task that more appropriately belongs there.
