REQUESTING THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO PROVIDE FEDERAL AID TO ASSIST AGRICULTURAL OPERATIONS IN VOG-IMPACTED AREAS IN MEETING THEIR WATER NEEDS.

Chairpersons Hanohano and Tsuji and Members of the Committees:

Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony on House Concurrent Resolution No. 8 and House Resolution No. 12 which seeks federal aid from the U.S. Department of Agriculture to meet the water needs of agricultural operations impacted by the effects of vog. The Hawaii Department of Agriculture (HDOA) supports the resolutions.

We wish to note that at this time there is an outstanding grant request to the Bureau of Reclamation to provide funds for water hauling for use similar to that described in the resolutions. HDOA will continue to work with our partners in the Federal, State and County agencies, non-profit organizations, UHCTAHR, and affected farmers and ranchers to address problems caused by the vog.
